Eu estou muito animado para brincar.



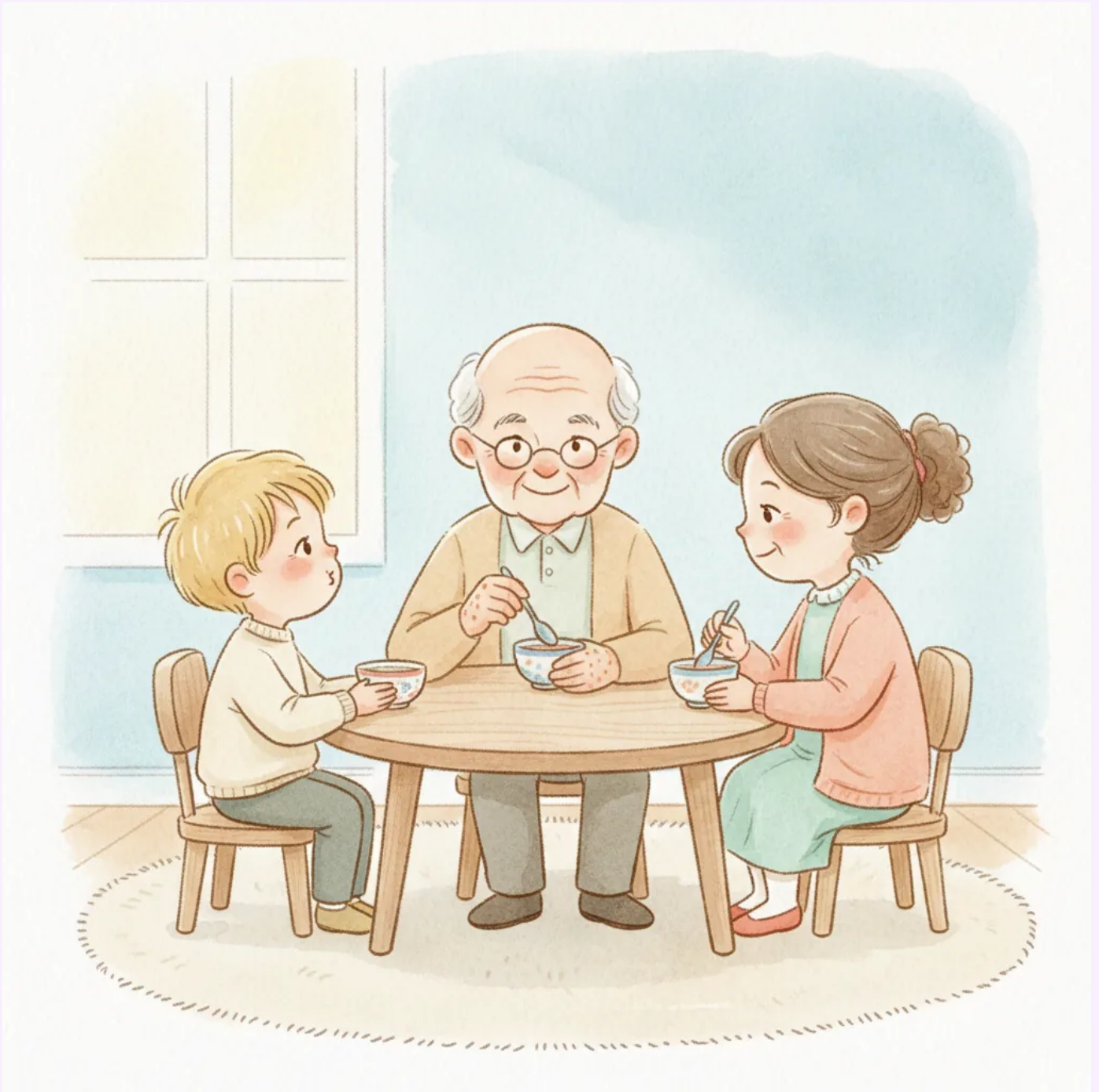
Primeiro, eles vão comer.



Eu quero brincar logo.



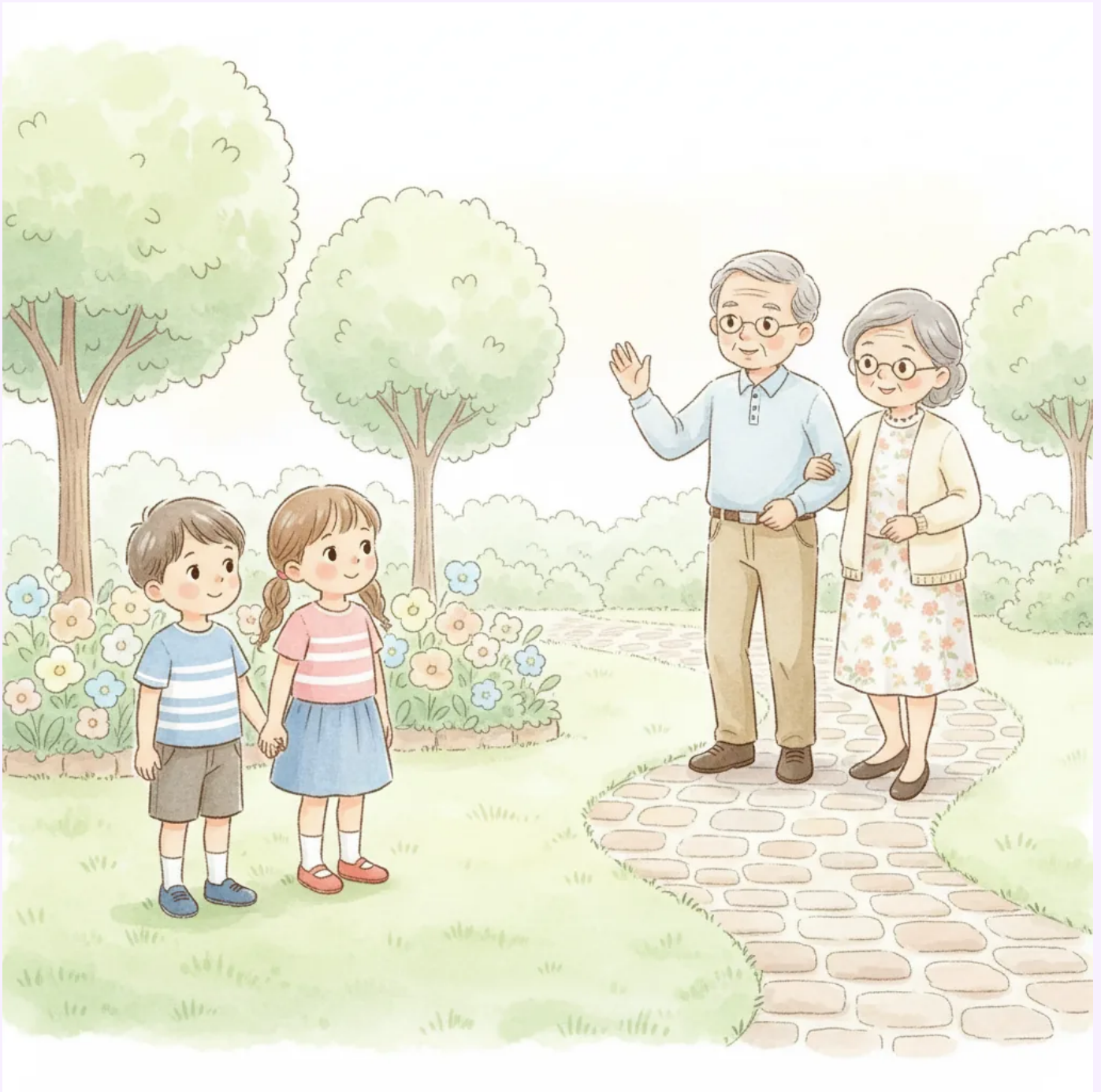
Mas, eu sei que preciso esperar.



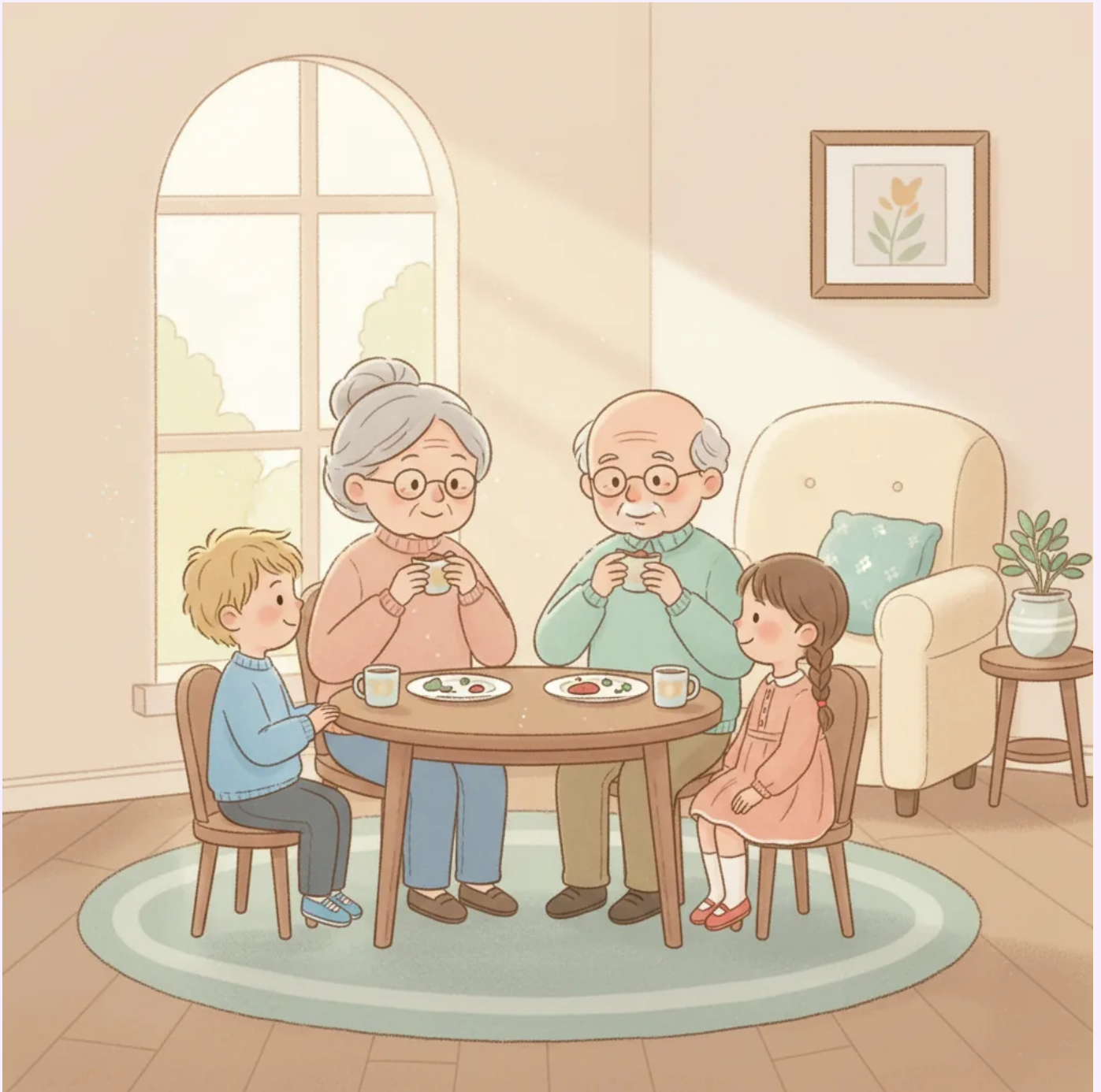
Eu respiro fundo e tento ser paciente.



Quando eles terminam de comer, eu sorrio.



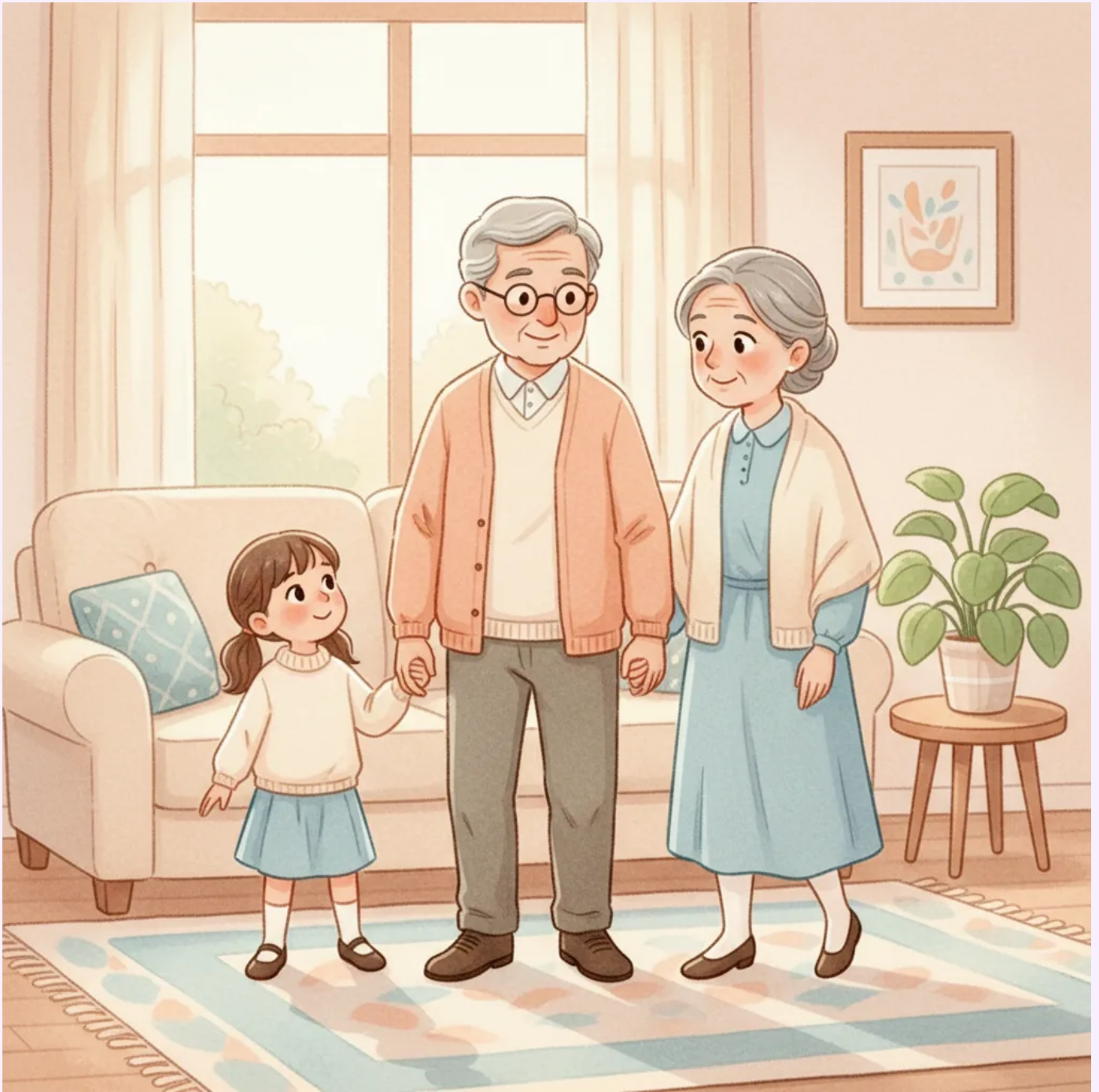
Nós vamos passear no quintal.



Meus avós andam devagar.



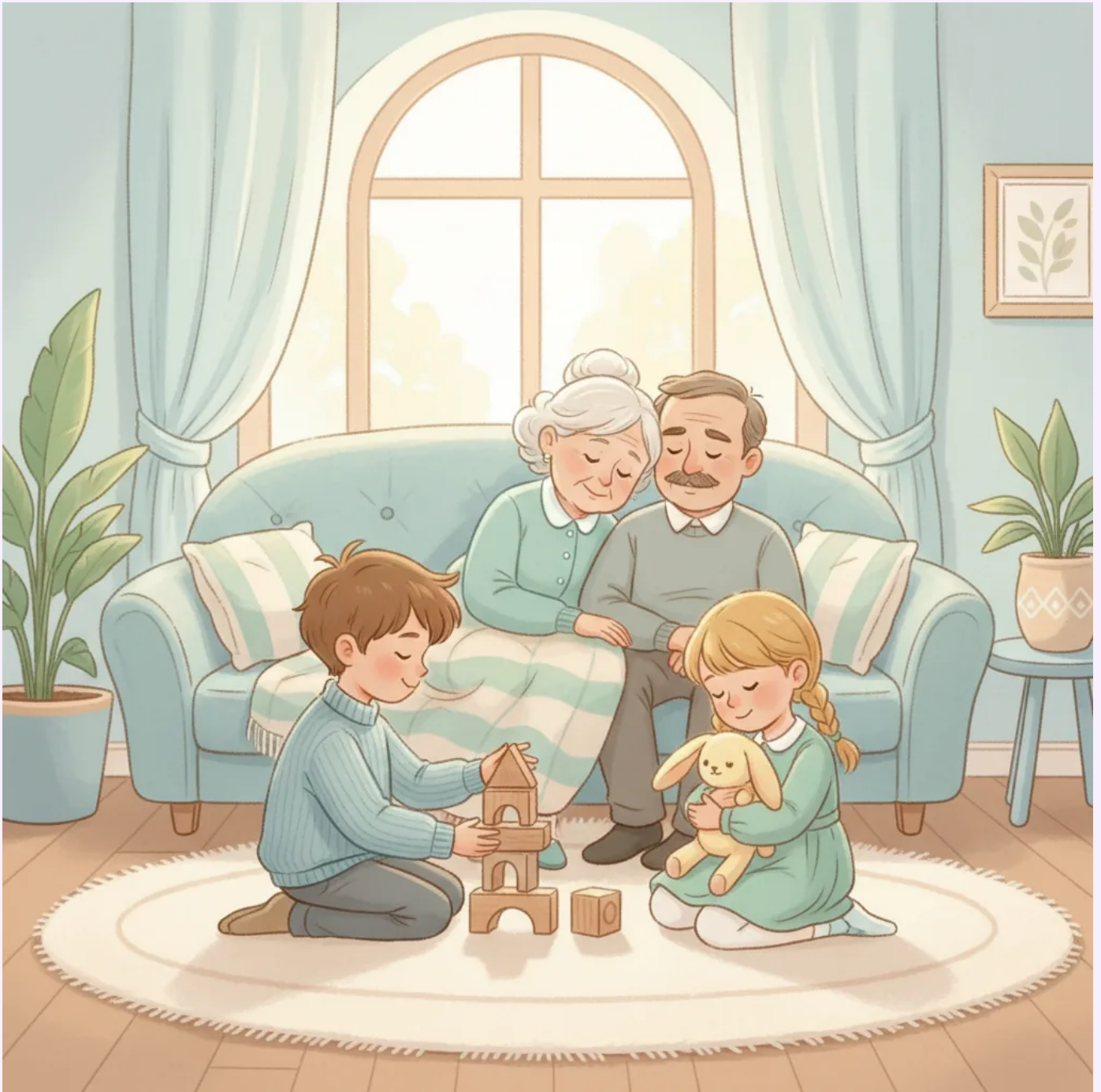
Eu tento andar devagar também.

Depois, meus avós se sentem cansados.



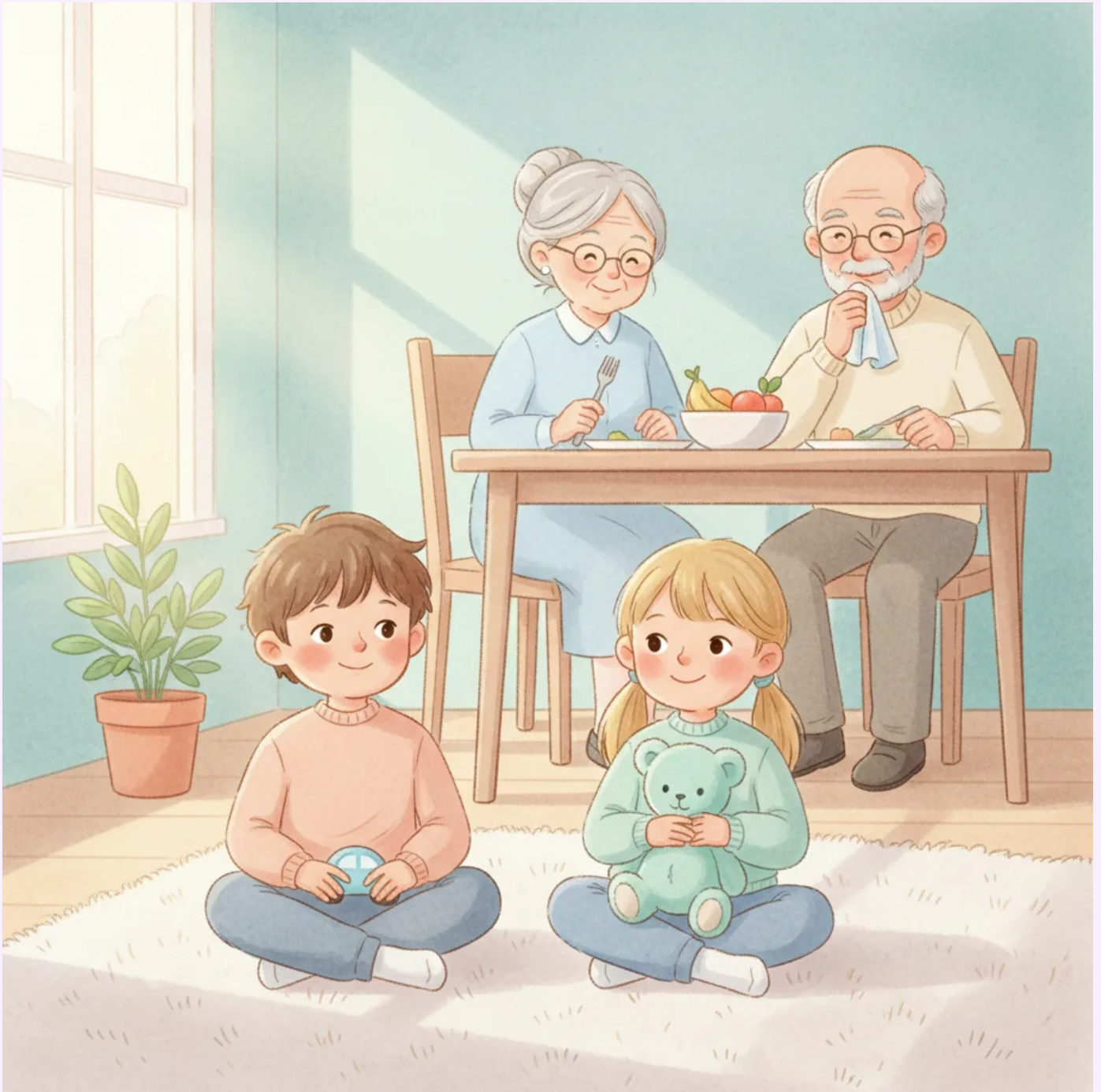
Eles precisam descansar um pouco.
