1. **THINK IT** "Even if a gift isn't what you wanted, it's important to appreciate the thought behind it. Always say thank you to show your gratitude."
2. **SAY IT** "It's important to express gratitude when someone gives you a gift, showing appreciation for their thoughtfulness."
3. **THINK IT** "It's kind to say thank you when someone shares something with you, even if you don't like it. You can politely decline without hurting their feelings."
4. **SAY IT** "When someone shares something with you, it's polite to thank them and show appreciation for their generosity."
5. **THINK IT** "Everyone has different skills, and it's great to appreciate your own effort as well as others'. Say something positive about your work and your friend's."
6. **SAY IT** "Expressing thanks for help received shows respect and appreciation for the teacher's effort."
7. **THINK IT** "When receiving a compliment, it's polite to say thank you and acknowledge the kindness, regardless of your personal preferences."
8. **SAY IT** "Thanking family members for their efforts, like cooking your favorite meal, shows appreciation and love."
9. **THINK IT** "Accepting praise gracefully is a part of showing gratitude. Your teacher is acknowledging your effort, and it's nice to appreciate that."
10. **SAY IT** "Accepting compliments graciously and acknowledging them shows confidence and appreciation."

11. **THINK IT** "Sometimes things don't turn out exactly as we hope, but it's important to be thankful for what we receive and focus on the positive."
12. **SAY IT** "Expressing gratitude when borrowing and returning items shows respect and appreciation for the friend's trust."
13. **THINK IT** "It's thoughtful to acknowledge a friend's help before suggesting any changes. Always express thanks first."
14. **SAY IT** "Thanking others for their help promotes a cooperative and supportive environment."
15. **THINK IT** "Handmade gifts should be treasured for the effort and love put into them, not just for how they look."
16. **SAY IT** "Appreciating when someone shares something special with you strengthens relationships and shows respect."
