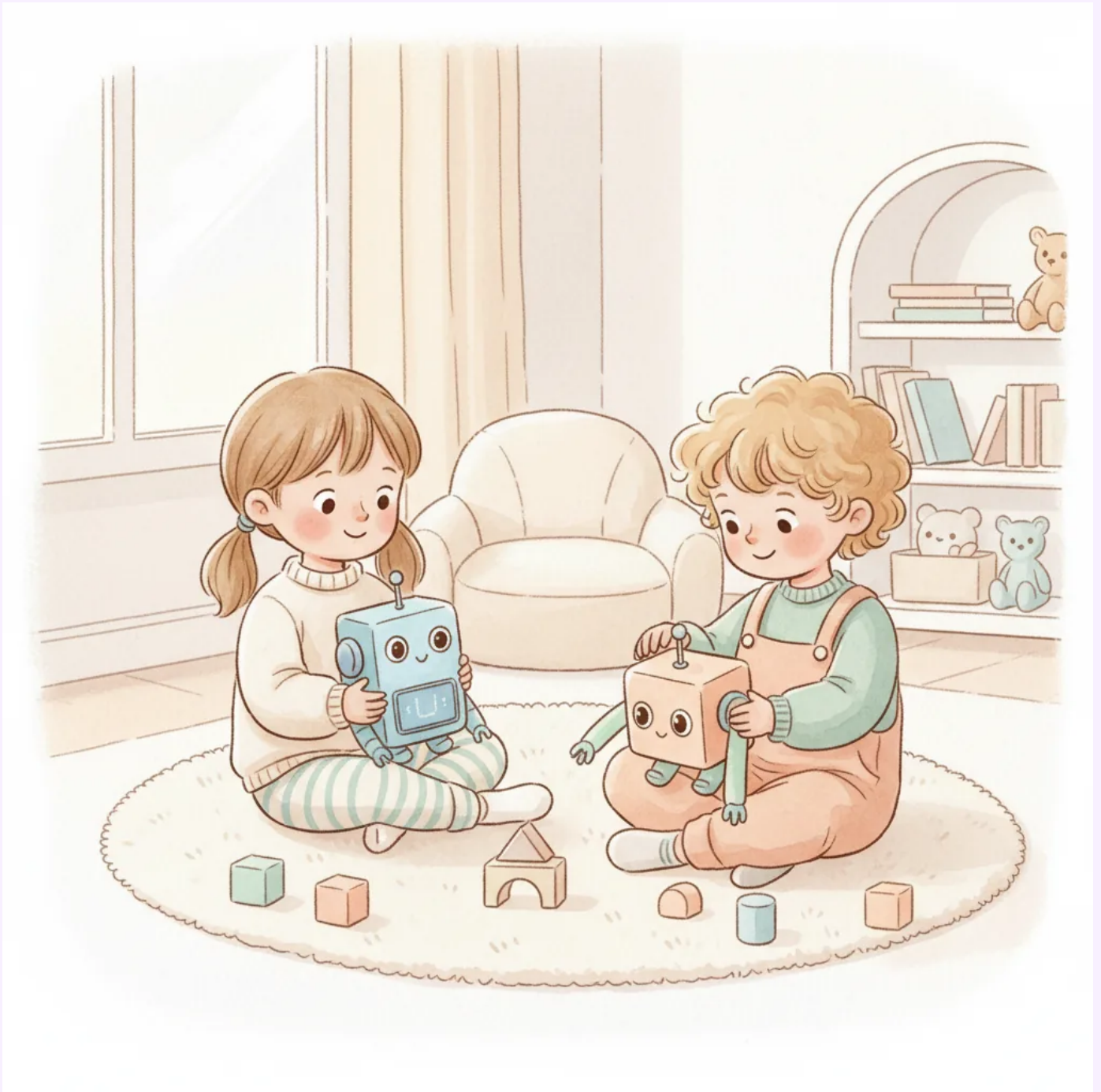




Friendly Robots and New Adventures

We took turns with the robots.



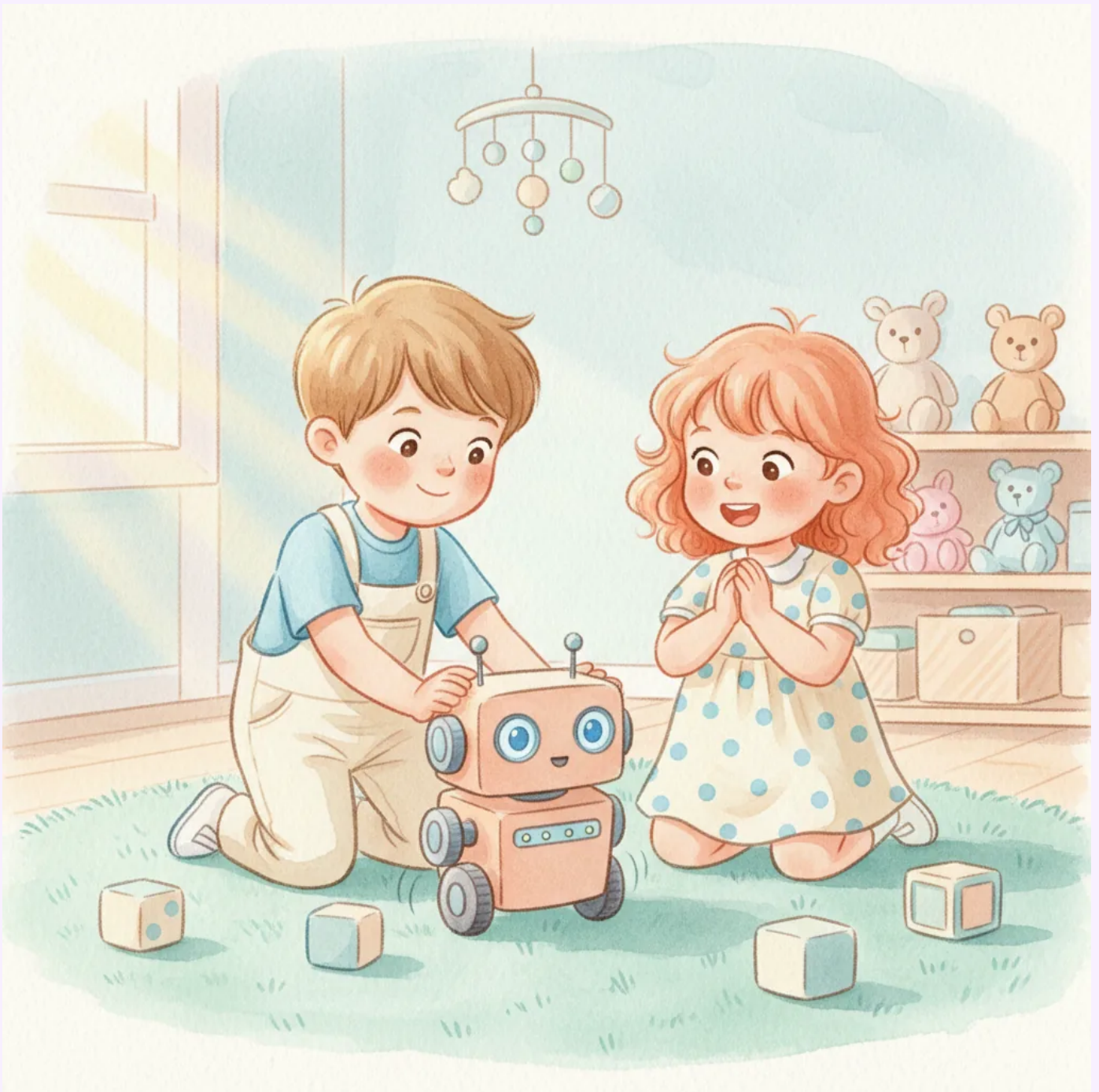
It was my turn first.

My friend moved the robot back.



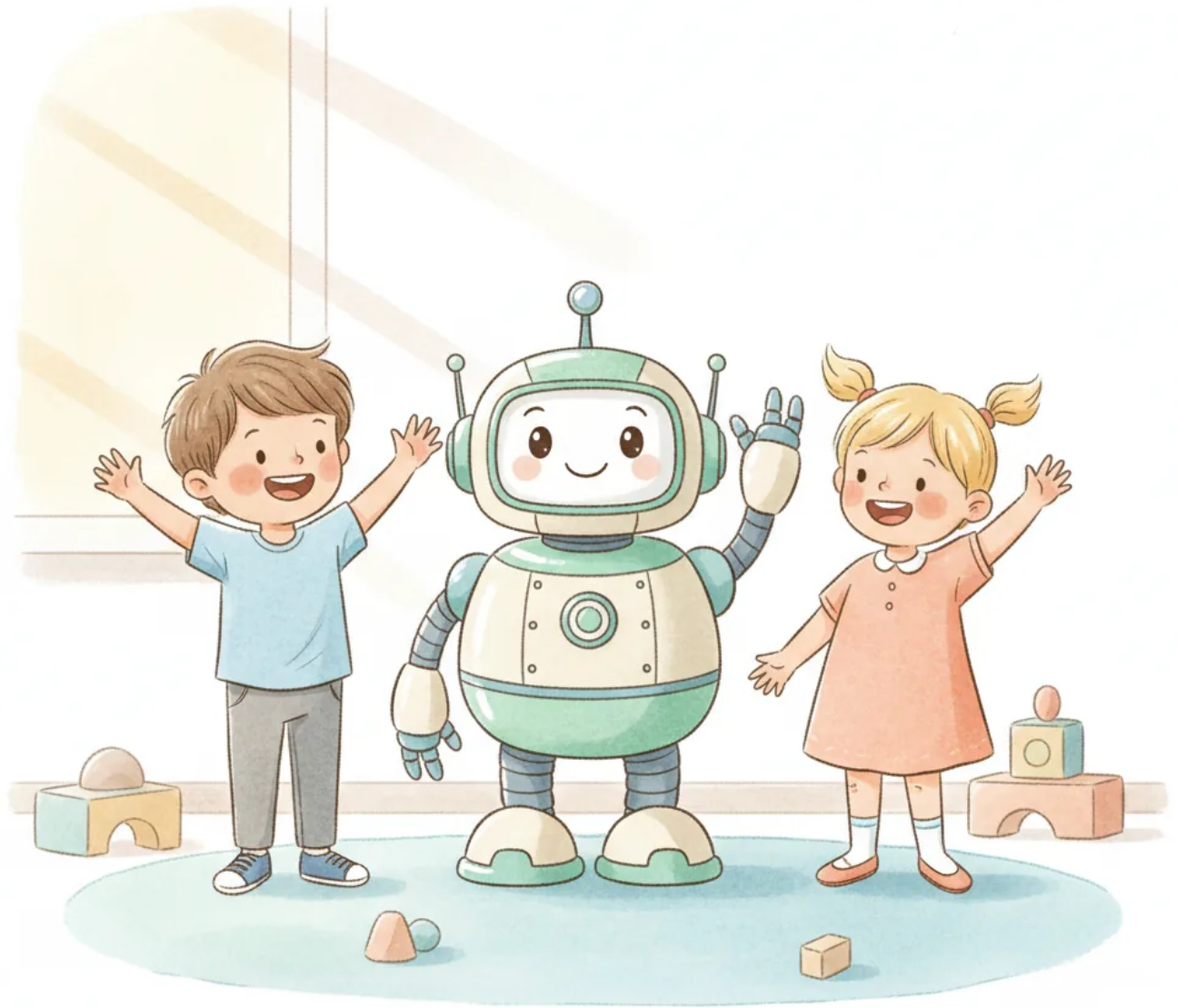
We laughed and played together.
