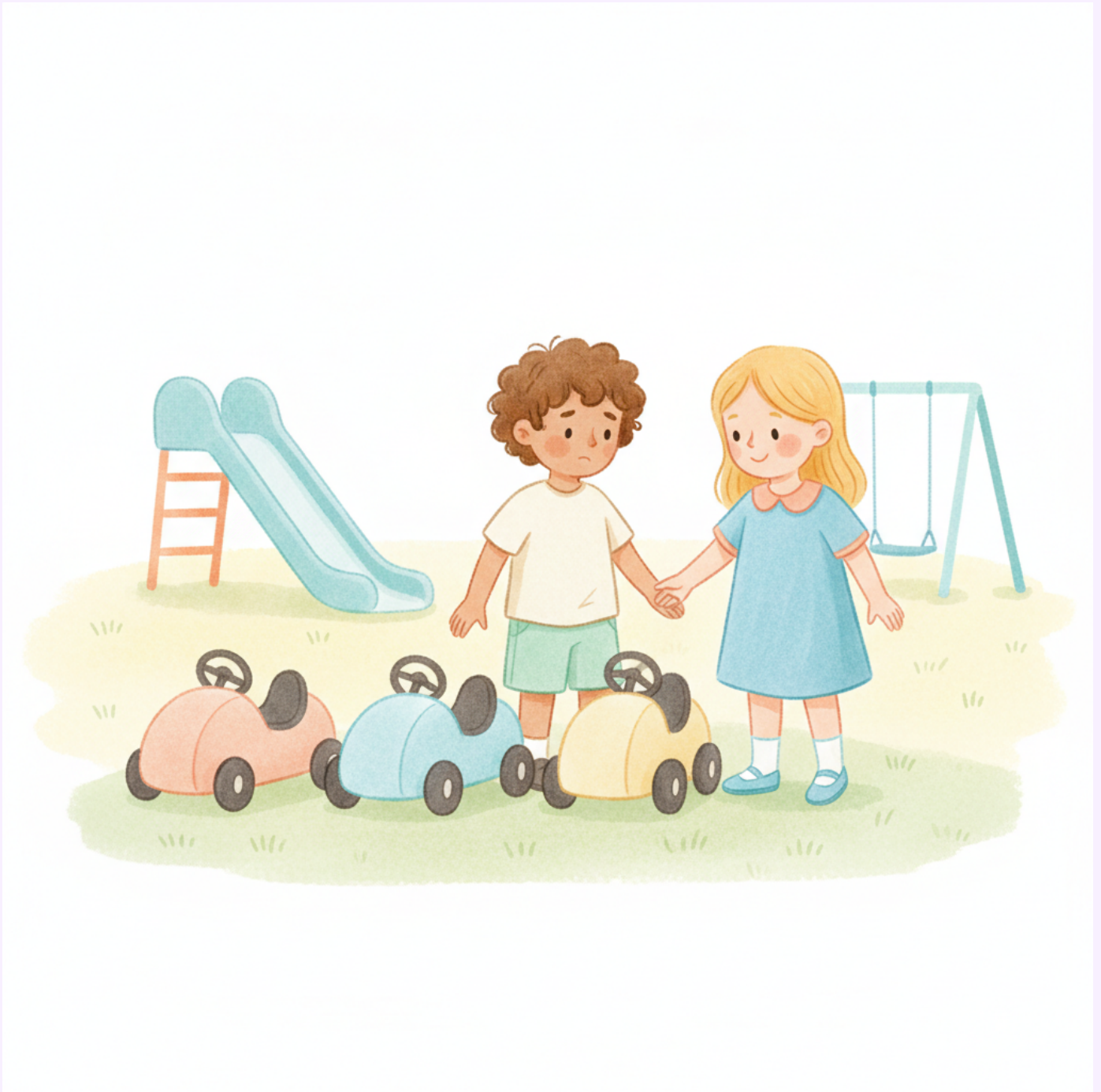




Racing Fun: Ready for the Go Karts Adventure
