When it was Mia's turn, I waited.



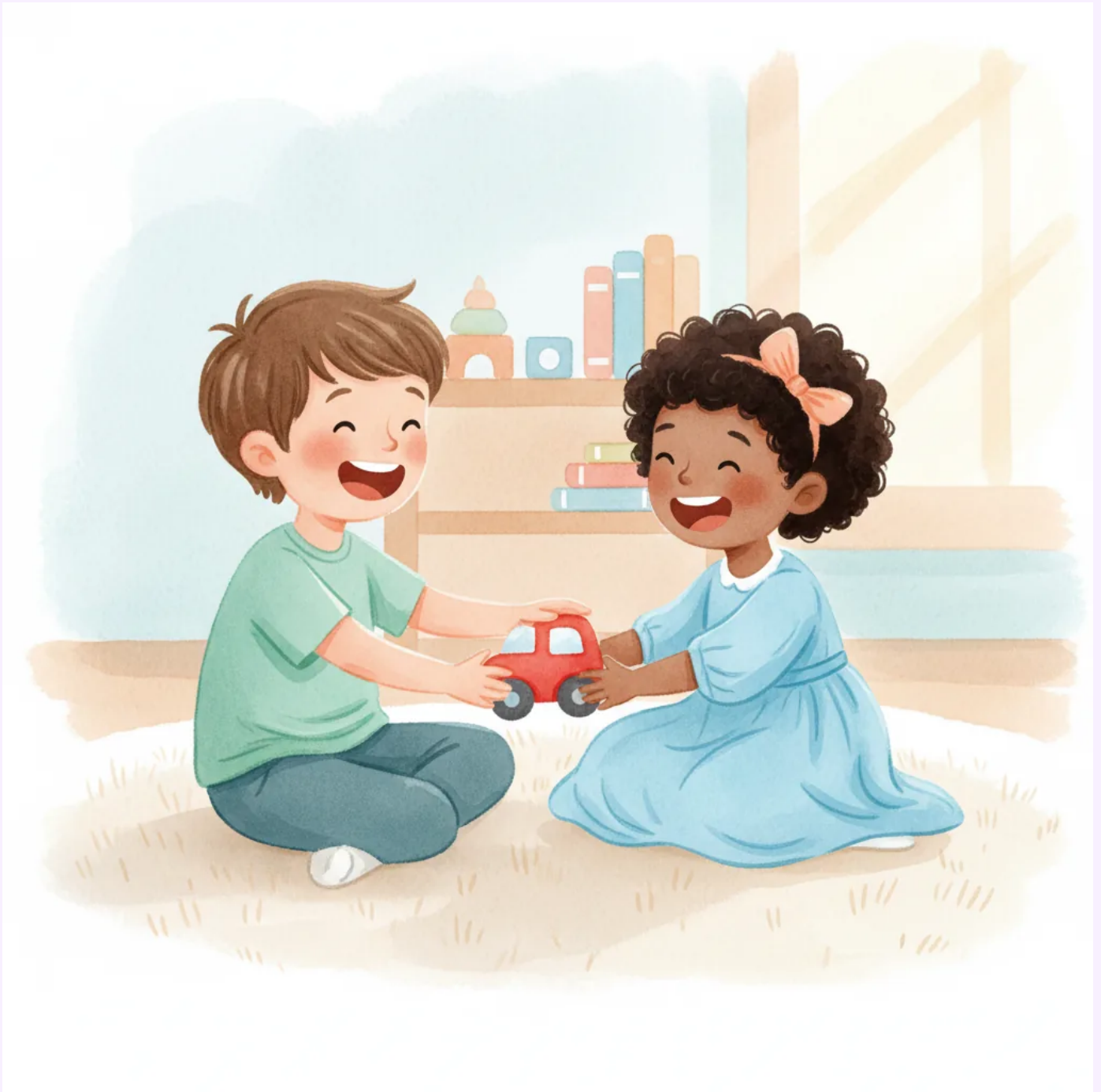
I said, "Your turn, Mia."
