I felt so happy going down the slide fast.



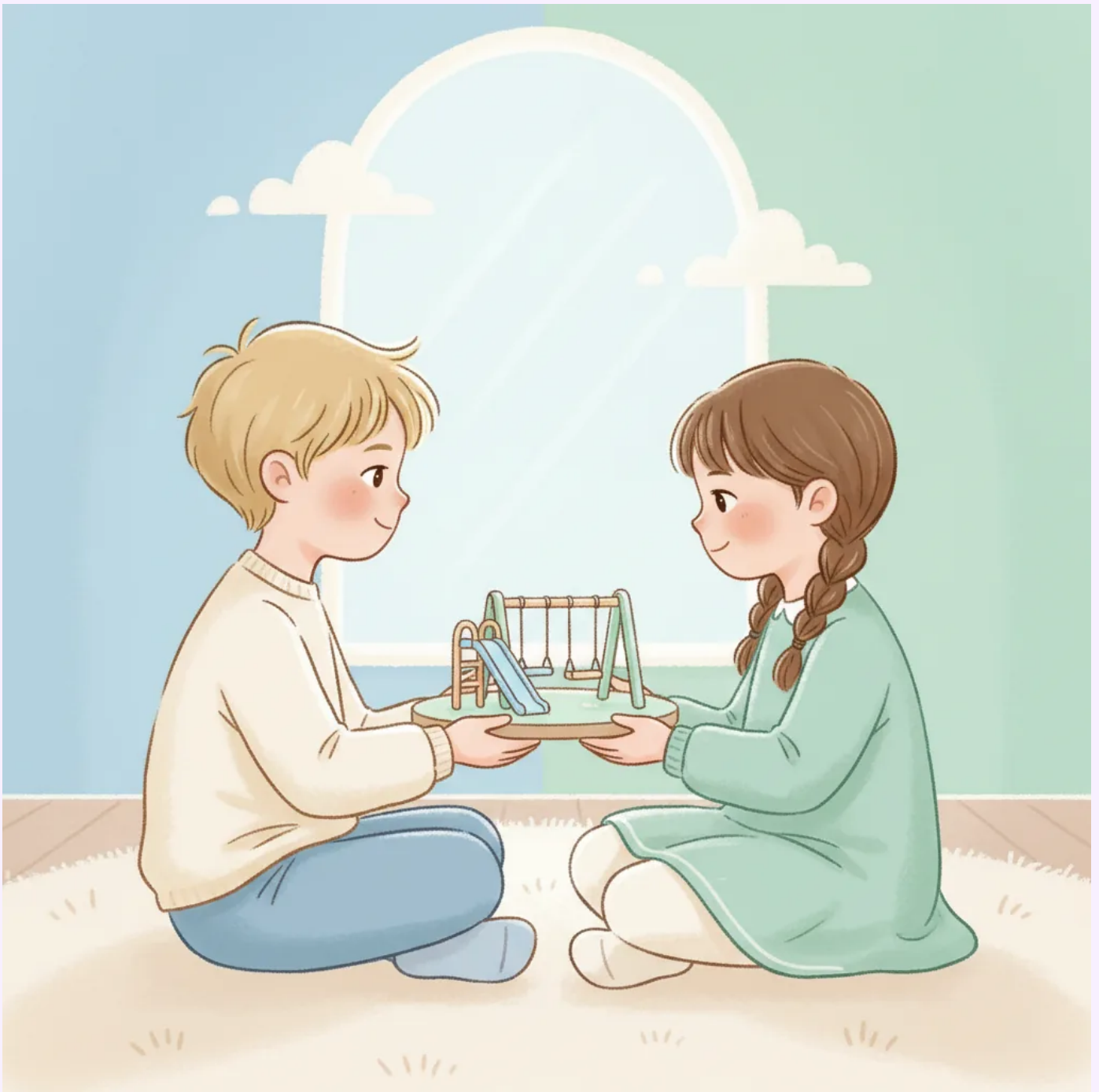
I laughed and swung high up to the sky.
